DIS	CRETIONARY Consecutive Sentence:
( )	Defendant committed the charged offense (not a major controlled substance offense) while <b>on bond</b> for another felony. MCL 768.7b(2)(a).
( )	Defendant's sentence for a <b>major controlled substance offense</b> may run consecutive to the sentence for any other felony as long as defendant was not on bond for the other felony when the major controlled substance offense was committed.
